


THE MESSENGER

Greetings!

We are about to enter the season of Lent. Lent is the season traditionally celebrated by penitence and fasting, if that can be called a celebration. But, before our season of fasting begins on Ash Wednesday, we will celebrate with a Fat Tuesday meal at 4 pm the day before!

Lent is the season that we attempt to focus on the last days of Jesus' journey to the cross. He was celebrated by many in the crowds; but, he was hated by even more. His journey and its end were not easy by any human standards. It was by no means a luxurious time for him.

When Jesus entered Jerusalem for his last Passover celebration, the crowds celebrated his entrance. But, by the end of the week, by the end of his journey to the cross, what were the crowds celebrating? There were celebrating his death!

Beginning with Ash Wednesday, we make a symbolic journey to the cross as well, remembering what Jesus has done for us and what we are called to do. We remember that he was willing to die for us and in fact did die for us. We remember that: "....Jesus told his disciples, 'if any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross and follow me.'" (Matt 16:24) Self-denial and following Jesus for the sake of others even as he denied his own comforts; his own life, for our sake, is our focus during Lent (as it should be the whole year).

It seems a bit old-fashioned in many people's minds to "give up" something for Lent. When you are trying to decide what or if you will fast from anything; please, remember what Jesus gave for you. Certainly there are things that we can all give up. Maybe, it is a little bit of time that we might sacrifice each day so that we can spend more time in prayer for others or to study his word. Maybe it is, as some do, giving up a food or drink that may not be very healthy for you. Maybe, it is that hour and a half on Wednesdays to worship and have a meal with the rest of the congregation. These are all small things in comparison to the life that was given for your life.

There is no doubt that taking up our cross and following Jesus to the cross can be troublesome; even deadly for some. But, as we follow Jesus on our journey to the cross this Lenten season, let us remember that the one who died that we might live is the King of Kings and he does live! Hosanna to the King!
